Unsolicited Advertising Circulars on vehicles or

residential property. (Legislative File ID 05-0082)

When you find flyers on your vehicle or on your property (fence, railing, door, porch, lawn, sidewalk, etc.), call 311 or use *www.baltimore.customerservicerequest.org* online.
An investigator will be dispatched, usually within 24 hours.
He/she will investigate, take photos and issue a citation to the responsible party. This offense carries a fine of up to \$50 per flyer.

*** Only the property owner or resident can request an illegal flyer investigation on private property. The flyer must be left where originally placed until after the officer arrives to gather evidence. Newspapers, community newsletters and political flyers are not considered illegal and will not be investigated or cited.

This is a simple way to begin cleaning up our community!
